Early lunch on own downtown Bar Harbor

12:30pm – Leave for Cruise Pier from downtown – 1.5 miles

1pm – Bar Harbor Sightseeing and Nature Cruise for 2 hours. "All cruises will provide a unique and memorable experience while visiting Bar Harbor and Acadia. Wildlife such as seals, eagles, harbor porpoise are a highlight." After the cruise our motor coach departs for downtown Main Street in Bar Harbor. Restrooms will be near the motor coach parking.

9am – Pick up Joe Vautour, who gives the historical tour from the State House opposite Boston Commons – oldest park in America – to the graves of John Hancock, Sam Adams, and Paul Revere. Also South Street Meeting House, where the Sons of Liberty left for the Boston Tea Party, to the site of the Boston Massacre – Joe is full of history and inspiration. We end at Quincey Market and the Statue of John Adams & Faneuil Hall. Quincey Market is the No. 1 spot in the city for lunch and shopping.

Noon – Lunch on own at Quincey Market. See Larry Bird's bronze basketball shoes. Sit by the bronze statue of Red Auerbach, legendary coach of the Boston Celtics.

1:15pm – Leave for Western New York

Dinner on own in route at the Cracker Barrel north of Syracuse, NY

9:30pm – Arrive Tops, Williamsville

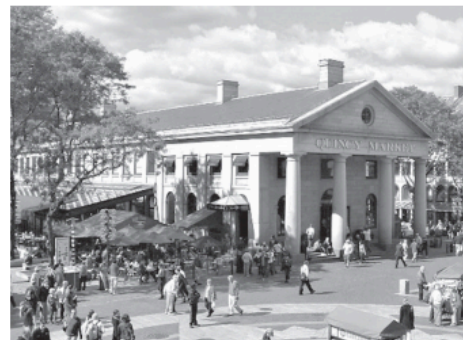
10pm – McDonalds, Meadow Dr., in North Tonawanda
