

Right To Vote for Women Seneca Falls Day Trip

Tuesday, July 20, 2022 Per person cost \$128

August 20, 2020 was the 100th Anniversary of the ratification of the 19th Amendment to the US Constitution. The movement for the right to vote got its start with a Women's Rights convention in Seneca Falls, NY on July 19-20, 1848. Seneca Falls is home to the Women's Rights National Historic Park. It is also home to the National Women's Hall of Fame which was founded in 1969 and is the nation's oldest membership organization and museum dedicated to honoring and celebrating the achievements of distinguished American women.

Itinerary

7:00am – Bus Reports to North Tonawanda

7:15am – Depart McDonalds, 315 Meadow Dr, North Tonawanda

7:45am – Depart Top's Parking Lot, 5274 Main St., Williamsville

10:00am – Visit National Women's Rights, Hall of Fame. In Pursuit of its Mission of "Showcasing Great Women... Inspiring All," the National Women's Hall of Fame honors women of the past, relates the history of women's struggles, prepares the women of the future and serves as the voice celebrating the value of women.

11:30pm – Short distance to Parker's Grille, Rated the # 1 of 24 Seneca Falls Restaurants.

1:15pm – Arrive at the Women's Rights National Historic Park. The first ever Woman's Rights Convention was a two day event, their final session wrapping up 174 years ago today. Held July 19-20, 1848 in the Wesleyan Chapel, We'll enter the park at the visitor Center, then see a film,

then join the park rangers for a talk and tour. (The schedule of tours and talks was not available at the time of this printing). There is also a bookstore.

3:00pm – Depart for the home of the most famous women’s rights activist, Susan B Anthony.

4:00pm – Arrive Susan B Anthony home, see the place Susan B. Anthony called home during the most politically active period of her life. Stand in the front parlor where she was arrested for voting in 1872. Experience her amazing story of courage and determination at this National Historic Landmark

5:00pm – Depart Rochester

6:10pm – Return to Tops, 5274 Main St. Williamsville

6:40pm – Return to McDonalds, N. Tonawanda
