8:45am – Vermont State House – One of the oldest and best preserved of our nation's state capitals. Self-guiding tour only. Jerry will give you a list of the recommended areas to see – 160 years old in the Greek Revival & Neoclassical style of architecture. The capital building is located in the smallest city of the 50 capital cities in the USA. About 45 minutes.
