7:45am – Bus Report time: McDonalds, 315 Meadow Dr., in North Tonawanda

8:00am – Leave for Tops, 5274 Main Street in Williamsville by Union Road

8:30am – Pickup at Tops, Williamsville

9:00am – Arrive at Broadway's Buffalo Market. By arriving fairly early we beat the crowds – it will be quite busy by the time we leave at 10:20am.

10:35am – Parker's British known for their "British classics" in food items on Aero Drive. Named Best British Shop in America and endorsed by the Royal British League. Scones and lots of British bakery goodies, pork pies and a lot of other tasty British pies. Go on Parker's website to see a list of wonderful British Goody items.

Noon – Arrive at DiPaolo's Restaurant: Garden Salad, Appetizer: Penne Pasta, 2 Meats: Breaded Pork Chop and Chicken Marsala, Vegetable & Potato, Warm Italian Rolls and Butter, Coffee, Tea & Dessert.

2pm – Weber's Mustard on 150 Reading St, Buffalo. The No. 1 mustard in WNY is their Horseradish Mustard. I can't wait to see this operation. I just picked up my daughter Julie Saturday night before the Bills vs. Chief's

game and she wanted to go to Wegman's. (Julie does the make-up for the CBS sports analysts out of NY City and had flown out to do the make-up for the game). There at Wegman's I met a guy from California who had 8 jars of Weber's mustard in his cart. I asked "I guess you're taking Weber's back to CA - how long will 8 jars last you?" "No, he replied, we will use them all up during the Bills-Chiefs game tomorrow".

3pm – Premier Gourmet Store on Maple Rd., – Last year at Premier, I saw some lemonade in a glass container from Italy. Of course, I wondered how fresh it was? Well it was absolutely delicious!

4:15pm – Now voted the No. 1 ice cream in Buffalo – The Parkside Candies on Main Street in Buffalo. It has been "remodeled" but they saved all of the essentials from the 1927 store. So much so – that they have earned the highest category in historical architecture status – HISTORICAL LANDMARK by both New York State and the Federal Government. Their old fashion ice cream parlor will be 100 years old in 2027.

5:30pm – Tops in Williamsville

6pm – McDonalds in North Tonawanda
