

# WHITE DEER DAY-TRIP to Romulus, NY

Thurs. Oct. 15, 2026 Cost Per Person: \$187

## Dear Way To Go Traveler,

Deer Haven Park occupies 3,000 acres of the former Seneca Army Depot (10,000 acres) and contains the world's largest number of all-white deer in the world (Total approximate number 200-300 white deer) and American bald eagles and an amazing array of Flora and Fauna. The former US ammunition storage facility (largest on the East Coast in WWII) closed in the year 2000. We will be stopping by for a chance to glimpse these majestic animals and "Discover Deer Haven Park." (PR piece, Deer Haven Park.). We will have our own personal guide. Also visiting the Women's Rights National Historic Park in Seneca Falls, and the Mennonite store Sauder's for unique items and produce.

## Our itinerary:

6:30am – Bus Report time, McDonald's 315 Meadow Dr., N. Tonawanda

6:45am – Promptly leave for Williamsville

7am – Arrive at Tops, 5274 Main Street by Union Road, Williamsville

9:30am – White Deer Haven Visitor Center Rt. 96A, Romulus, NY

10am – Leave on 90 minute tour to see the rare, rare white deer in the park and other interesting wildlife and plant life.

11:30am to Noon – Depart for Lunch

12:15pm – Lunch at Knapp's Winery, No. 1 Restaurant in Romulus. Entree Choice Below.

1:45pm – Dave & Rita's Bakery in Romulus, NY stock up on White Deer Granola, White Deer Crunch, White Deer Food, and even White Deer Poop, a popular stocking stuffer. Also Fresh Donuts, Assorted Pies, turnovers, and unique breads like "Italian sausage, green peppers & onions".

2pm – Women's Rights National Historic Park in Seneca Falls, NY Visitor Center – 22 minute film, Dream of Equality then half an hour to see the exhibits at this Visitor Center.

3pm next door at the Wesleyan Chapel – Park Ranger Talk in the very building where the 1848 Women's Convention took place. (In 2020, I had 20 women signed up for a whole day in Seneca Falls celebrating the 100th anniversary of women receiving the Right to Vote thru the passing of the 19th Amendment.)

3:30-3:45pm – Sauder's Store in Seneca Falls, NY – So many unique items, roasted coffee, old fashioned jams,

fresh ground peanut butter, old world spices, books, games, puzzles, wind chimes, toys, soaps & candles. Sauder's feels they have the freshest produce anywhere. This is a well-known Mennonite store - the best in the area.

6pm – Arrive at Tops on Main Street near Union Road

6:30pm – McDonalds, Meadow Dr., in North Tonawanda
